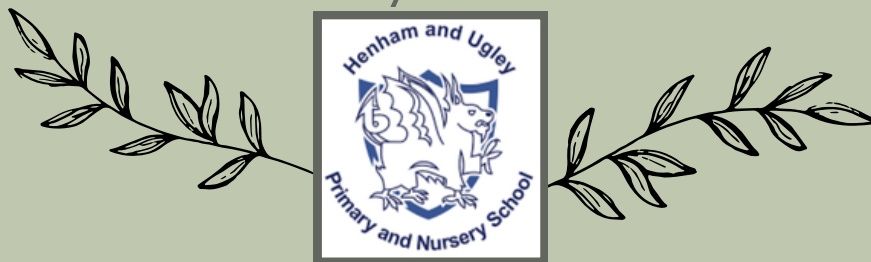

Year 5 have been writing poems, this one particularly made me giggle!

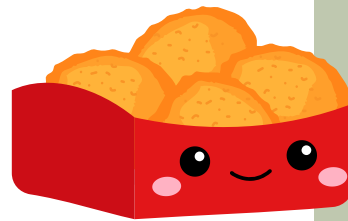
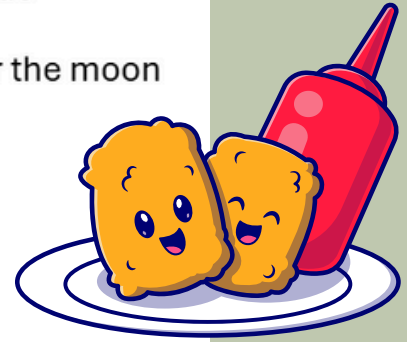
I love chicken nuggets, and most people do

My love for you is bigger than my house

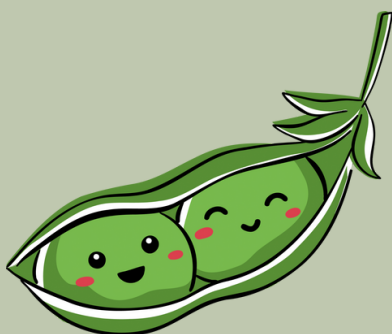
Forever you will be my munch

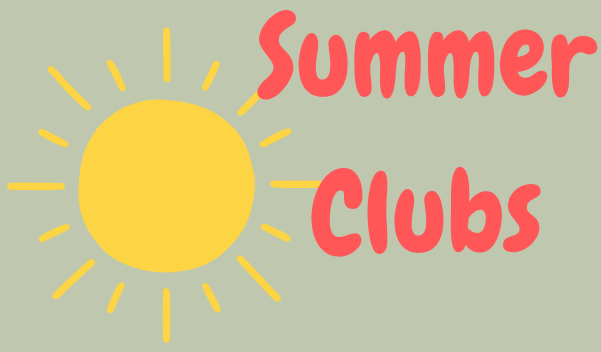
