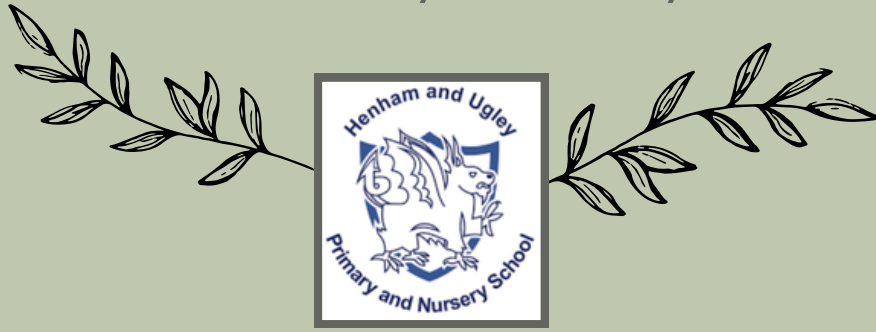

Mrs B's kindness award

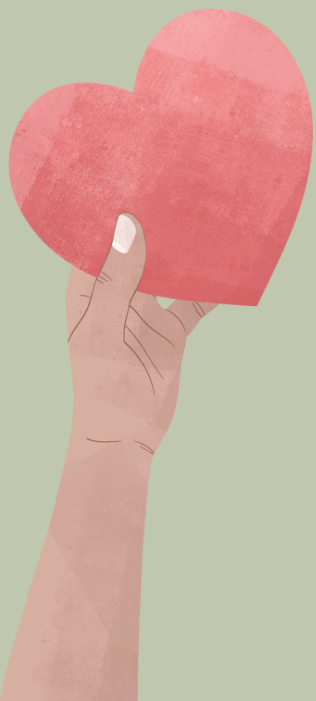
Every week, Mrs B and the team will be looking out for children who are showing exceptional kindness, they will be awarded our special 'kindness' award.

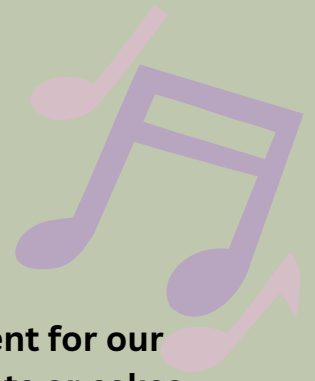
