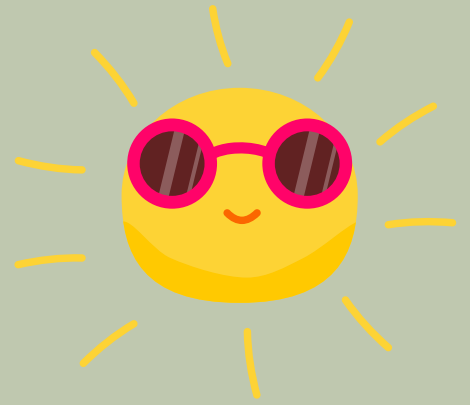

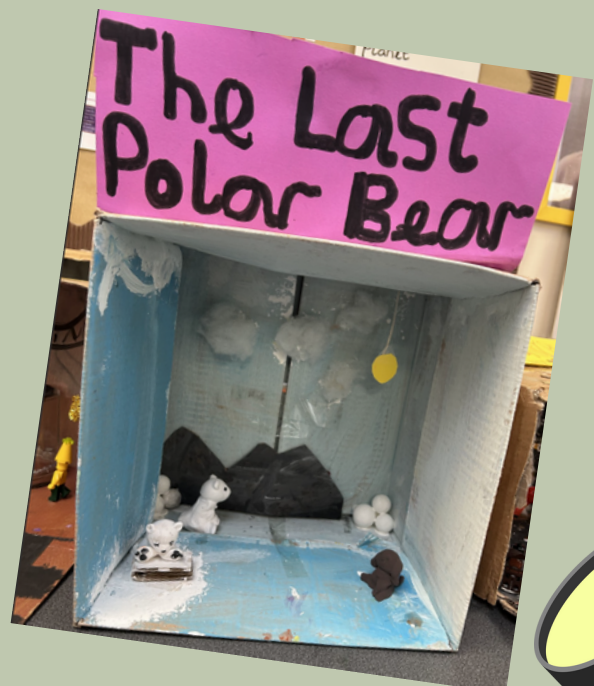
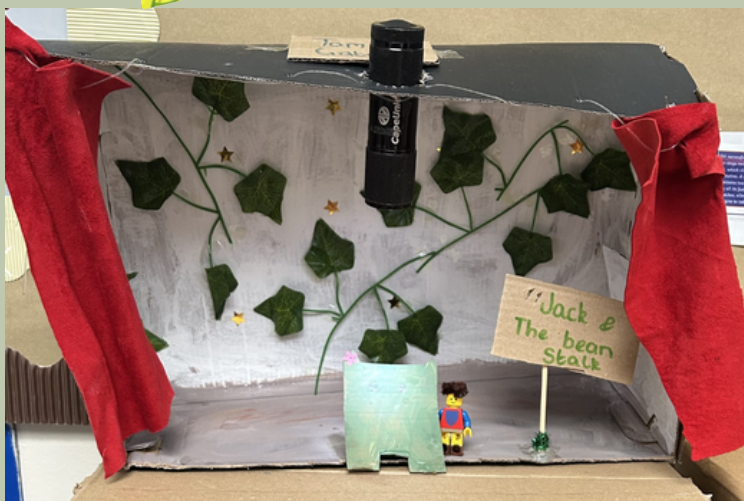
For showing kindness & a caring attitude during our sports day practise - helping the younger children, checking they were happy & understood the rules.

Olivia in Year 4 for demonstrating her kindness on the KS1 playground - you really are everyone's friend Olivia!

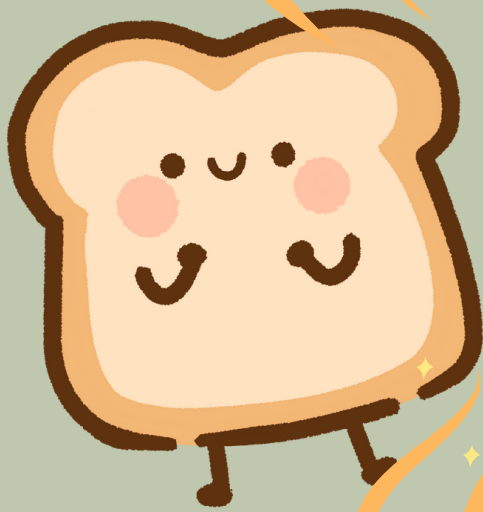


YEAR 5'S THEATRE SETS.

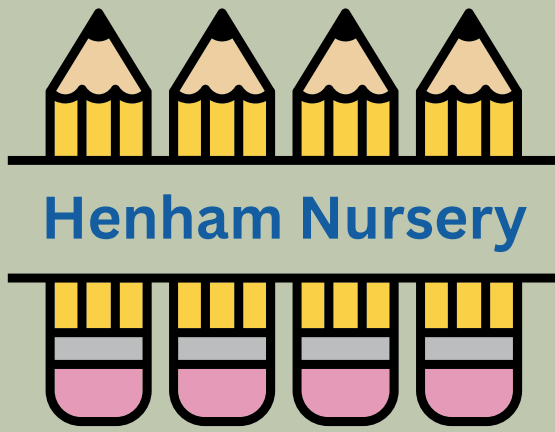
