# Keep Your Child Safe *Online*

## A Guide for Parents

### 1 Check Parental Controls

Check that your parental controls are up-to-date and use them to restrict access to inappropriate content and monitor online activity.

### 2 Set Clear Expectations & Boundaries

Establish rules for online activities. Define time limits, appropriate content, and allowed websites or apps.

### 3 Supervise Online Activities

Keep an eye on your child's online behaviour. This can involve periodic checks, co-viewing, or sitting with or near them during their screen time.

### 4 Be a Good Role Model

Set a positive example with your own online behaviour. Demonstrate responsible use of technology, respecting others' privacy and maintaining a healthy digital life.

### 5 Encourage Open Communication

Create an environment where your child feels comfortable discussing their online experiences. Especially if they have any worries or concerns.

### 6 Ensure a Healthy Balance

Ensure that your child has a balanced routine with enough time away from a screen for physical activity, hobbies and family interactions.

### 7 Educate About Online Dangers

Talk to your child about the risks of being online, such as cyberbullying, predators and inappropriate content. Explain how to recognise and report these dangers.

### 8 Know the Platforms

Familiarise yourself with the apps, games and websites your child uses. Understand their features, privacy settings and potential risks.



# Reminder



## NUT & SESAME Free School

**We are a totally Nut Free & Sesame Seed Free School:**

Although we recognise that this cannot be guaranteed, Henham and Ugley Primary and Nursery School aims to be a strict Nut-Free/seed Free school to reduce the risk to those children and adults who may suffer a reaction if exposed to nuts/seeds to which they are sensitive.

- Please do not allow nuts/seeds or nut/seed products in lunch boxes or break time snacks that are brought in from home. Our "Nut/seed -Free School" means that the following items should not be brought into school:
  - Packs of nuts
  - Peanut butter sandwiches
  - Chocolate Spread (made with nuts) sandwiches
  - Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
  - Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
  - Sesame seeds i.e. rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
  - Houmous
  - Cakes made with nuts
  - Cakes or biscuits made with coconut oil (children allergic to cashews may also have a severe reaction to coconut)

Please check ingredients on all products.

We do not use nuts/seeds in any of our food prepared on site at our school. Our suppliers provide us with nut-free products. However, we cannot guarantee freedom from nut traces.

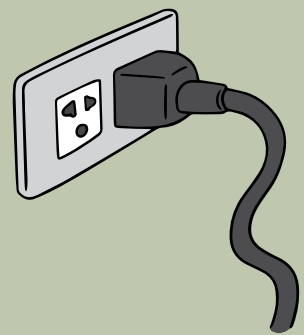

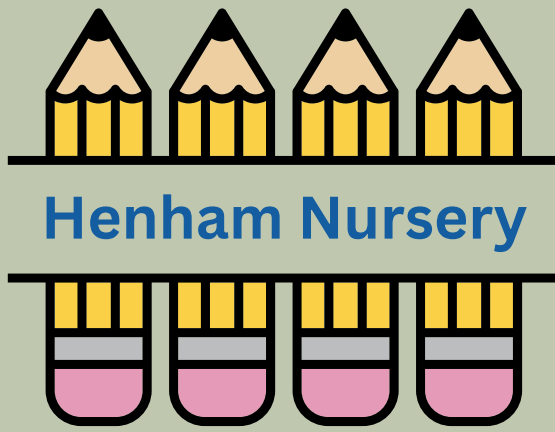
