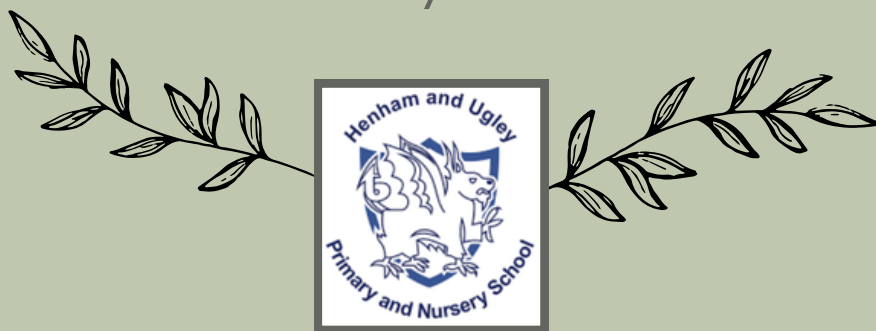

This is an opportunity for you to look at the work your children have produced through the year.

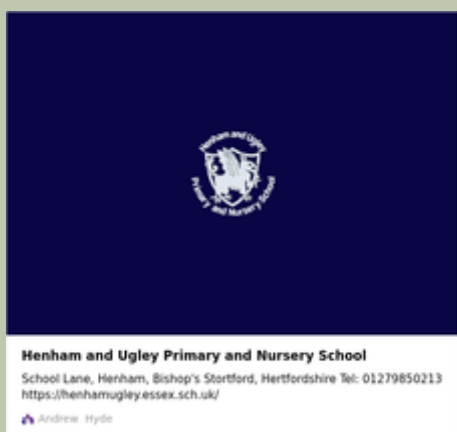

TouchPoint - Stansted



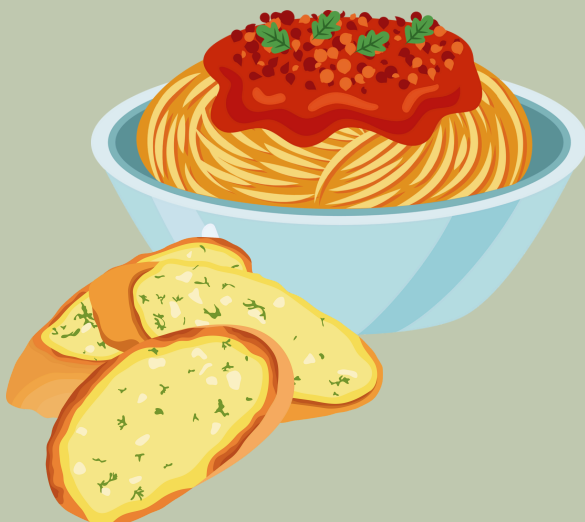

NUT & SESAME Free School

We are a totally Nut Free & Sesame Seed Free School:

Although we recognise that this cannot be guaranteed, Henham and Ugley Primary and Nursery School aims to be a strict Nut-Free/seed Free school to reduce the risk to those children and adults who may suffer a reaction if exposed to nuts/seeds to which they are sensitive.

- Please do not allow nuts/seeds or nut/seed products in lunch boxes or break time snacks that are brought in from home. Our "Nut/seed -Free School" means that the following items should not be brought into school:
 - Packs of nuts
 - Peanut butter sandwiches
 - Chocolate Spread (made with nuts) sandwiches
 - Fruit and cereal bars that contain nuts
 - Chocolate bars or sweets that contain nuts
 - Sesame seeds i.e. rolls (children allergic to nuts may also have a severe reaction to sesame)
 - Houmous
 - Cakes made with nuts
 - Cakes or biscuits made with coconut oil (children allergic to cashews may also have a severe reaction to coconut)

Please check ingredients on all products.

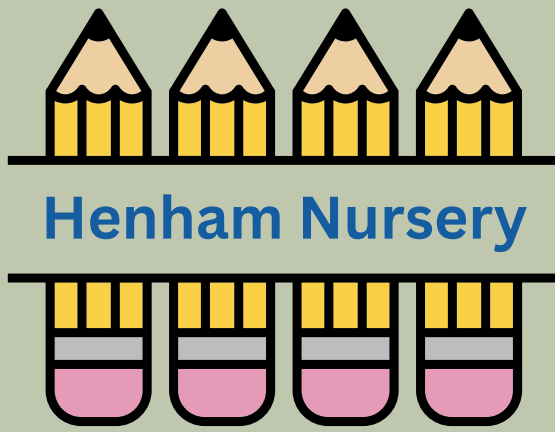
