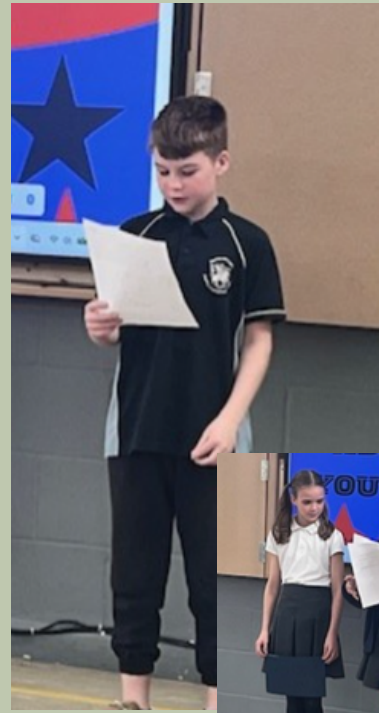

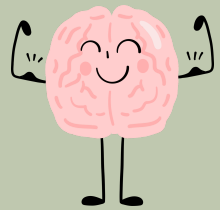


We are a healthy eating school

Thank you.

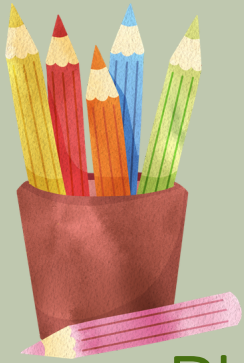
