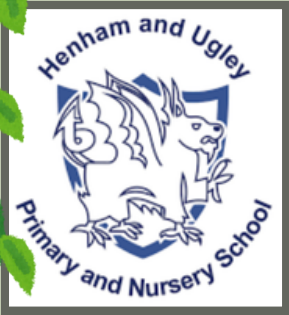

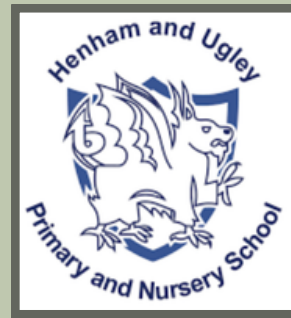

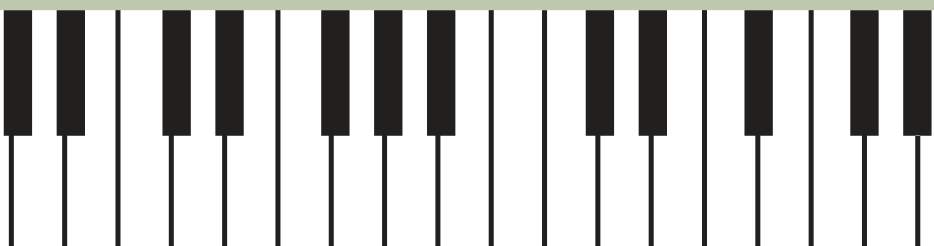
Receiving photos of children did make me sad!

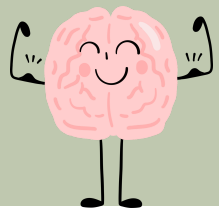

Please could you ensure grapes, cherry tomatoes and olives are cut up - they can pose a choking hazard. Thank you.

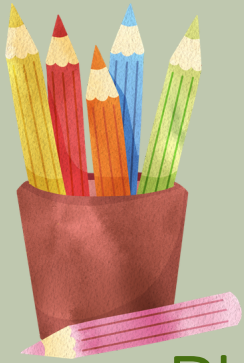
