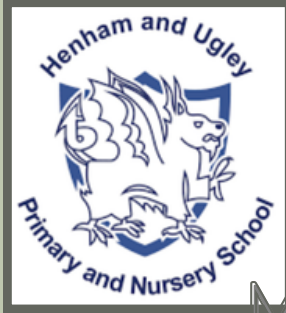

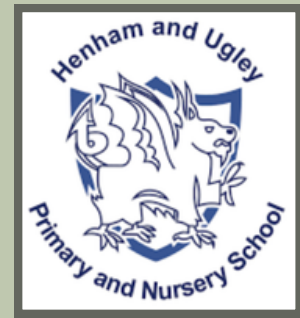


This term we are

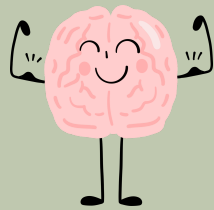


## Nursery Sports Day & Graduation Ceremony
